








## English Activities

I would like you to write me a few sentences every day about what you have been doing at home.




You could write about:

I would like you to choose a story and tell me a bit about it.






I would like to know:



4. This week I have chosen two stories to focus on and I'd like you to read both!

 Tell me  which one  you  liked  more and  why







Have a  look in your  garden or on your  daily walk and  see if you can
