
After he finished school, he spent his early life working as a tax collector.

He taught himself to paint in his spare time, and started displaying his work at galleries in 1886.

He is best known for his jungle scenes, such as *Tiger* in a *Tropical Storm* (Surprised!)



Tiger in a Tropical Storm (Surprised!) 1891 by Henri Rousseau




Henri Rousseau

This was a stylised form of painting, which means that he didn't try to paint things exactly as they look in real life.










Henri Rousseau also played the violin.


Surprised Tiger Jungle Scene





Using pencil and wax crayon/oil pastel, follow the instructions below to draw your stylised* tiger. *Stylised = non-realistic
