Read through the resource below, which provides information about the rise in people wanting to work in the healthcare industry. Did you know about all the different jobs within healthcare? Are you surprised at how many people work in this sector?



The NHS stands for the National Health Service. It refers to the UK Government's health and medical care service that everyone in the UK can use.

The number of people registering an account on the NHS Jobs website has increased from 61,000 to 82,000 over the last month!

The number of people looking to study medicine has soared during the pandemic and the NHS Health Careers website has seen a 220% rise in Britons expressing an interest in becoming a nurse!

There are around 350 different types of jobs in healthcare! Including ambulance paramedics, dentists, pharmacists, office staff, scientists and cleaning staff.

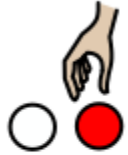

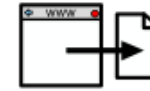
