Other FUN activities you could do:

Nature Photo Frames

You will need:

- four large sticks or twigs
- a selection of stones
- a selection of flower heads and stems
- grass
- a selection of leaves
- petals



The Activity:

1. Go on a nature treasure hunt around your garden or near to your home. Allow your child to be creative and search out lots of different items, collecting as many items and colours as possible.
2. Decide with your child what material they would like their photo frame to be made out of. It could be made from sticks, flower stems, wooden planks or even lots of small stones. It could even be a mixture of different items, depending on what you find.
3. Create your photo frame making a square shape.
4. Using your collected items, create a picture inside your photo frame. Your child could create a portrait of themselves or a picture of something that makes them happy e.g. a pattern, a place, another person or an animal.





Leaf Necklace

Outdoor Activity

You will need:

A selection of leaves

String

Small stick

Scissors

Hole punch (optional)

The Activity

1. Cut a length of string long enough for a necklace. Tie a small stick to one end of the string - this will act as the needle. Tie a large knot on the other end.
2. Allow a child to choose leaves for their necklace.
3. You may wish to make threading holes with the hole punch or you may wish for the children to make the holes themselves, either using the hole punch or a thin, firm stick.
4. Once the leaves have been threaded, cut off or untie the stick and tie the necklace into a loop.
5. Allow the children to wear their creations.





Making Magic Wands

Outdoor Activity

You will need:

Sticks or twigs (suitable sizes to make into magic wands)

Glue

Sticky tape

Ribbons

Scissors

Glitter

Sequins

The Activity

1. Go on a stick hunt and collect one stick each to make into a magic wand.
2. Choose some ribbons and tie them to the end of the wand.
3. Add glitter and sequins.
4. Leave the magic wands to dry.
