Dear Parent/Carers,

Industrial Action

As you will be aware from my previous communication, the National Education Union (NEU) balloted members on strike action, which it has stated will go ahead on Wednesday 5th and Friday 7th July 2023. While the planned action is the result of a dispute between the union and the government, this action will have an impact on our school. In anticipation of this action, we have prepared a response plan to try to minimise disruption and ensure as many of our pupils as possible are still able to attend school in person. Unfortunately, we may still need to make changes on the day.

Our plan is currently to CLOSE the following classes on Wednesday 5th July ONLY:

Buttercup - class teacher Ms Sarah Lovell Bluebell - class teacher Mr Ben Thompson Sunflower – class teacher Miss Lucy Woodward 8EC - class teacher Miss Emily Curran 9SC – class teacher Miss Shara Clark

Our plan is currently to **CLOSE** the following class on **Friday 7th July ONLY**:

9KD – class teacher Mr Kevin Doherty

All other classes will remain **OPEN** as usual. However, it is within the staff members' rights to not make a final decision until the day of the proposed strike action, so this position may change. Lesson links for remote learning will be sent out before 09:30 in the morning.

We appreciate that industrial action is disruptive and you may need to change your plans or working arrangements whilst this action is ongoing. We will of course continue to monitor our arrangements and make modifications to improve support wherever possible. If the strike action is called off, we will confirm this as soon as possible. If this happens, then school will be open as usual for all pupils.

Please advise your transport provider if your child's class will be closed.
